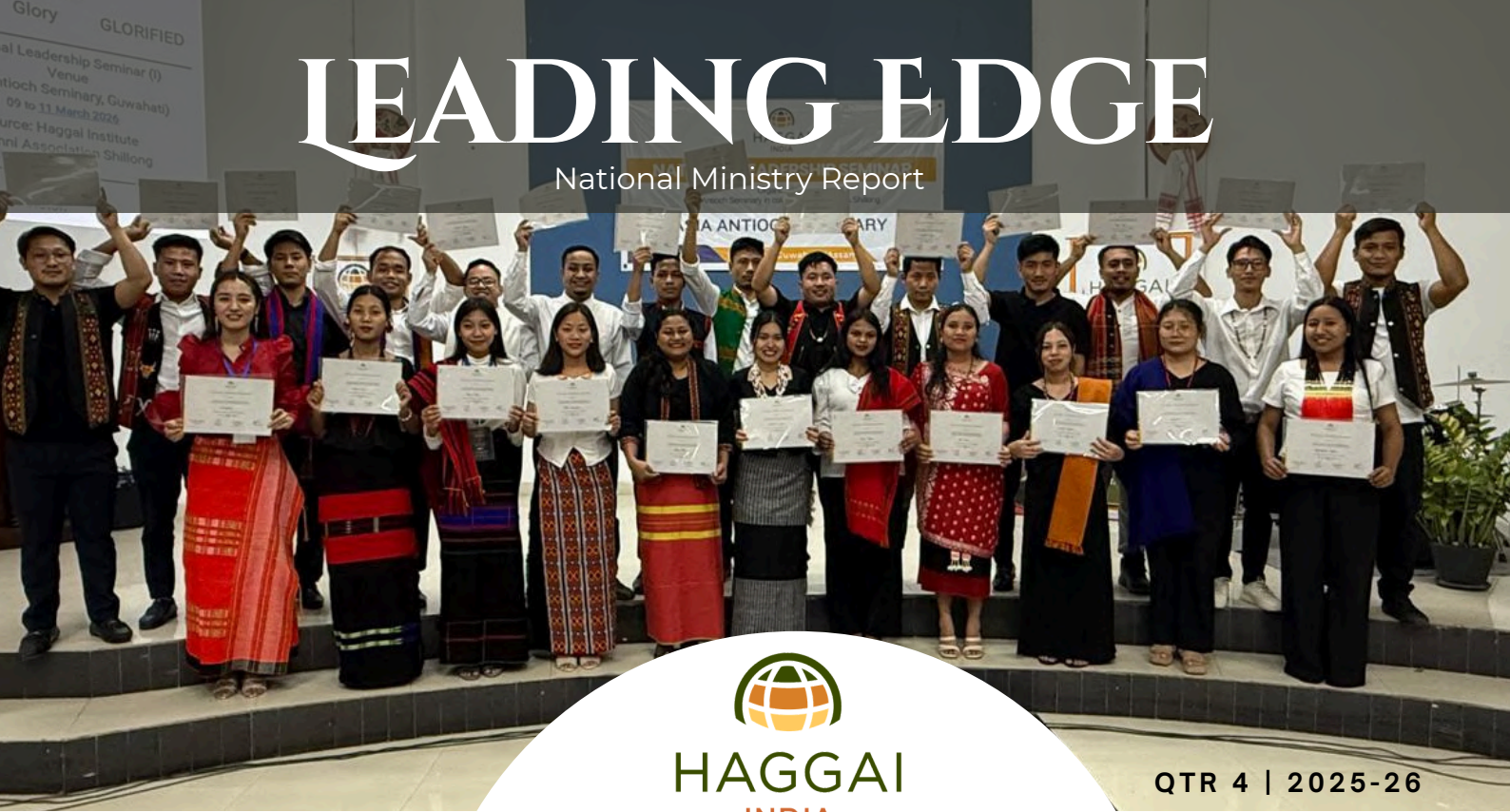

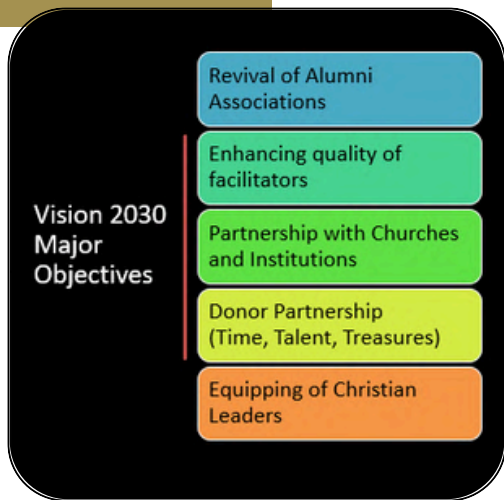
## What this meant for me

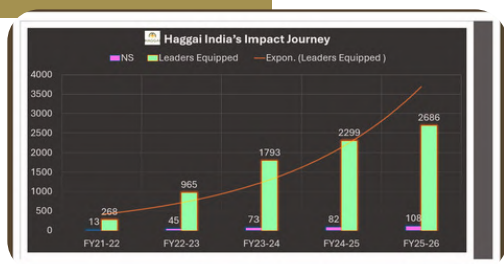
## Strengthening Impact Through Strategic Focus Areas

Firstly, the collective efforts invested in the comprehensive review and updating of seminar subject matter content have borne fruit. This process not only ensured that our offerings remained relevant and in tune with current challenges but have also enhanced the overall quality and effectiveness of our seminars. As a result, participants found the sessions more engaging and applicable to real-world scenarios, leading to a marked rise in active involvement and positive feedback.

Secondly, the strengthening of partnerships with major protestant and catholic church organisations and institutions has significantly contributed to our reach. These collaborations have opened new avenues for engagement, enabling us to connect with a broader audience and share our vision more widely. Through these alliances, we have been able to foster deeper relationships, facilitate knowledge exchange, and create opportunities for greater collective impact.

## Seminar Statistics: Growth and Reach

Last year, we organised 108 National Seminars, equipping 2,686 leaders across the country. This achievement represents a growth of over 12% compared to our annual target, and nearly 16% more than the previous year. We also conducted many promotional seminars as we consider them to be impactful from a biblical perspective. Staying true to our approach of “people groups reaching people groups,” 74 out of the 108 seminars were delivered in local languages such as Hindi, Marathi, Bengali, Telugu, Tamil, Oriya, Kannada, Assamese, Mizo, and Garo, in addition to English, a total of 11 languages.

The seminars were held in 26 out of the 28 states of our country. We praise God for providing us with such versatile facilitators, some of whom are even trilingual!

## Real-World Impact: Stories of Transformation

The impact of our seminars is best seen in the lives of the participants. For instance, after attending a leadership seminar in Assam, one participant was inspired to launch a local outreach programme in her village. This initiative brought together youth and elders to address pressing community needs, demonstrating how our training translates into real-world transformation.

Being part of National Leadership Seminar has changed me from the inside out and became a turning point in my life. I discovered what it truly means to lead with love and serve with compassion. It helped me stay grounded in faith, led by grace and committed to walking with God every day.
